WB shuffles over 500 officials before EC's roll revision drive

67 IAS & 460 WB Civil Services Officers Transferred

Kolkata: Bengal govt has transferred 67 IAS and 460 state civil services officers in one of its largest single-day administrative reshuffles yet, moving 14 district magistrates, besides key civic and infrastructure officials.

The sweeping changes come months before EC's special intensive revision (SIR) of electoral rolls, which begins this week in New Delhi and will start soon in Bengal. Under Article 324(1) of the Constitution, the SIR process vests EC with powers of "superintendence, direction and control" similar to those it exercises during elections. Administrative officers such as DMs and block development officers serve as electoral

registration officers during this phase. Many of the transferred officers had been in their posts between two-and-a-half and four years and were close to breaching EC's rule barring officials from holding the same post for more than three years when elections are announced.

Bengal's assembly polls are expected by March 2026, and EC's schedule for electoral roll verification is seen as a precursor to the election calendar. "The transfers were routine," a senior state officer said, but officials acknowledged that carrying out such a reshuffle after

EC's process began would have been "much more complicated and difficult". Legal experts said once SIR starts, EC's direct oversight limits the state's power to reassign key officers. The reshuffle order — signed Friday — comes amid what insiders described as "feelers" from EC over the "slow pace" of SIR preparations in some districts. "DMs also become district electoral registration officers once the SIR process starts and come under EC's direct purview. EC could have asked for transfer of those DMs with whose work it was not satisfied," a retired bureaucrat said.

States bound by Constitution to support SIR: CEC

New Delhi: The EC asserted there will be no hurdles in the implementation of special intensive revision of the voters' list in West Bengal as states are constitutionally obliged to provide the poll authority with personnel to carry out the electoral roll clean-up exercise.

Responding to a question on possibility of "bloodbath" in West Bengal if SIR is held there, Kumar said, "There is no hurdle." "The EC is doing its duty and state govt are constitutionally-bound to discharge their duties...all constitutional bodies carry out their responsibility as enshrined in the constitution," Kumar said, citing the EC's powers under Article 324 of the Constitution. "Maintaining law and order is a state's constitutional responsibility... states are also bound to provide necessary personnel to EC for preparation of electoral rolls and conduct of polls," he added.

CEC: SIR in Assam will be announced separately

New Delhi: Chief Election Commissioner Gyanesh Kumar on Monday said separate provisions of the Citizenship Act apply in Assam, and a special order will be issued for the special intensive revision of electoral rolls in the state.

Assam did not figure in the list of 12 states and Union Territories where the electoral roll clean-up exercise has been announced from November 4.

Addressing a press conference here, Kumar said a Supreme Court-supervised exercise to verify citizenship is about to be concluded in Assam, and the state has separate provisions with regard to citizenship under the Citizenship Act. "A special order will be issued by the Election Commission to hold SIR in Assam," he said. "Under the Citizenship Act, there are separate provisions for citizenship in Assam. Under the supervision of the Supreme Court, the exercise of checking citizenship is about to be completed. The June 24 SIR order was for the entire country. Under such circumstances, this would not have applied to Assam," Kumar said.

BJP expels its six leaders for 'anti-party activities'

Bhagalpur: The Bihar unit of the BJP expelled six party leaders, including Kahaigaon MLA Pawan Yadav, for indulging in "anti-party activities". According to a party statement issued on Sunday evening, the expelled leaders, including the MLA, have also been suspended from the party's primary membership.

"The party took disciplinary action against them after it found that all six leaders were indulging in anti-party activities against the NDA nominees during the ongoing assembly elections in the state. The sitting MLA of the outgoing assembly, Pawan Yadav, who was denied a ticket by the party this time, is contesting against the NDA nominee from Kahaigaon seat as an independent candidate," it said. Others expelled from the party were Sunny Yadav, Shrawan Kushwaha, Uttam Choudhary, Maruti Nandan Maruti and Pawan Choudhary.

Reacting to the development, a senior BJP leader said, "These expelled leaders were working against the officially declared candidates of the NDA nominee, and against the ideology of the party." The Bihar Assembly will go to polls in two phases on Nov 6 and 11, with results on Nov 14.

Rahul to address rallies in Bihar's Muzaffarpur, Darbhanga tomorrow

Patna: Congress leader Rahul Gandhi will kick off his campaign for the assembly polls in Bihar on Wednesday with rallies in Muzaffarpur and Darbhanga districts.

Gandhi's first rally will be at the reserved constituency of Sakra in Muzaffarpur, where the party has fielded Umesh Ram, the runner-up of the 2020 polls, said a statement issued by Rajesh Rathore, the chairperson of the state Congress media cell, on Monday.

The leader of the opposition in Lok Sabha is expected to be joined by RJD leader Tejashwi Yadav, the chief ministerial candidate of the INDIA bloc, said Rathore. Later, Gandhi will address another rally in the adjoining Darbhanga district in support of the INDIA bloc candidates.

He highlighted that the first phase of the SIR was completed in Bihar with zero appeals.

"SIR will ensure no eligible elector is left out and no ineligible elector is included in poll rolls," Kumar said at a press conference.

The CEC ruled out any confrontation with the West Bengal govt, where the ruling Trinamool Congress has expressed reservations about SIR. "There is no hurdle between the Election Commission and the state govt. The Commission is doing its constitutional duty by carrying out the SIR, and the state govt will discharge its constitutional duties," Kumar said. The CEC said state govt were bound to provide the necessary personnel to the EC for the preparation of electoral rolls and conduct of polls.

On the demands for putting off SIR in Kerala on account of local bodies elections, Kumar

said the notification of the local bodies elections was yet to be issued. Unlike Bihar, the pan-India SIR will not require the residents to submit any documents during the enumeration phase. Also, a separate box has been added to the enrolment form to record one's own or parents'/relative's details from the last SIR in 2002/2003/2004. "Ones not linked to the last SIR roll will be issued a notice to prove their eligibility with one of the 'indicative' documents," said Kumar.

On the pressure that BLOs may face in states opposing SIR, EC said it is confident that all states/UTs will discharge their constitutional duty under

Article 326 by placing their personnel at its disposal for SIR, and also maintaining law and order.

On transfers of SIR-related officers in states like West Bengal after announcement of SIR, a senior EC functionary said it signals that these states are ready for SIR despite threatening to not allow it.

Sources said that nearly 70-80% voters in the 12 states may find a link to the last SIR roll, thanks to digitisation, an elector in one state/UT can locate his or her parents' name in any other state/UT roll from the last SIR. The CEC said an elector is required by law to sign and submit only one enumeration form, or face legal action.

The "indicative" list of documents accepted as proof remains the same as in Bihar: Aadhaar will be accepted only as proof of identity. "If during the hearing, a person offers an alternative document, it will be considered by the ERO," assured the CEC.

Congress: Neither voters nor Oppn satisfied with SIR

New Delhi: Soon after the EC on Monday announced holding SIR of electoral rolls in 12 states, the Congress questioned the exercise, and said the poll body's intentions and credibility were under suspicion as neither the voters nor the opposition were satisfied with it.

In a video message posted on X, Congress media and publicity head Pawan Khara said, "We have not yet received answers to the questions related to the SIR conducted in Bihar so far. The situation was such that the Supreme Court had to step in several times to rectify the SIR in Bihar."

"The intentions of the Election Commission and the BJP, which has made the EC its puppet, regarding Bihar's SIR have already come to light before the entire country. "Whenever SIR happens, Election Commission employees go to every house, add new voters, and delete those who need to be deleted."

But not even a single voter has been added in Bihar, whereas 65 lakh votes have

been deleted as part of the SIR exercise, which raises several questions, Khara said. Now they (EC) are repeating the exercise in 12 states, he said.

The Congress leader said that following the revelation of 'vote theft' in the Aland Assembly constituency in Karnataka by Rahul Gandhi, the SIT has said that a centralised operation was being carried out to strike names from the voter list.

"We will come to know about the details of this after the SIT probe is complete in Karnataka," he said.

"Amid all this, conducting the SIR by such an Election Commission whose credibility and intention are under suspicion does not seem right. Clearly, neither the people, nor the opposition or the voters are satisfied," Khara alleged in the video message.

The Election Commission will conduct Phase-2 of the SIR of electoral rolls in 12 states and Union territories, Chief Election Commissioner Gyanesh Kumar announced on Monday.

Uddhav targets BJP, says today govt choosing who can vote

Mumbai: Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray on Monday accused the ruling BJP govt of vote theft by asserting that voters elect governments in democracy, but today the government was choosing the voters.

Addressing party workers here, Thackeray said that a case should be registered against the Election Commissioner for "corrupt practice" of allowing bogus voters to vote in elections.

He said that after winning the Lok Sabha polls and forming the government at the Centre, the Election Commissioners will be booked and will have to face trial.

The BJP gave the call of "Atmanirbhar Bharat" but it still cannot become atmanirbhar because it resorts to breaking parties and "stealing" votes, the former Maharashtra chief minister said.

He also dubbed the BJP as a bogus gang of self-proclaimed patriots.

BJP doesn't need 'crutches' in Maha, asserts Amit Shah

Mumbai: Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Monday declared that the BJP doesn't need crutches and runs on its own strength in Maharashtra, challenging the party cadre to ensure that the opposition is defeated during the ensuing local body polls in a manner that they are "not seen even with the help of binoculars."

Speaking to party workers after laying the foundation stone of the Maharashtra BJP's new office building near Churchgate railway station in south Mumbai, Shah asserted, "We have proved that the politics of family-run parties will no longer work in this country. It is the politics of performance that will lead the nation forward." Shah cited PM Narendra Modi as a model for the party, saying "Modiji is the best example of this. A child born in a humble tea seller's home rose, through his dedication, sacrifice, and hard work, to become the prime minister of India."

Referring to the 'double engine' govt of the BJP at the Centre and in the state, Shah said the party must also secure victories in the local body polls scheduled later this year.

He was responding to a reporter's question on Union minister Amit Shah's statement at a party event here that BJP in the state does not run on crutches but on its own strength. "Those who question this remark do not understand the meaning of 'crutches'. Friends are not crutches," said Fadnavis.

He said the name change was in line with previous such

decisions by his government to "restore" the names of places changed by erstwhile rulers. Addressing a gathering during the 'Smriti Mahotsav Mela 2025', Adityanath said his govt was now spending funds on reviving sites with religious and cultural significance as opposed to previous regimes "constructing boundary walls of 'kabristan'".
